<b>July 2011</b>	Higher Education Handbooks available via iLearn
<b>7 July</b>	Higher Education Day & Fair
<b>By end of June</b>	UCAS goes 'live' for 2012 applications
<b>5 + 6 September</b>	College UCAS days = Year 13s Apply for Student Loan/Maintenance Grant Evening meeting for parents + students on University application, Uni finance
<b>1 October</b>	College deadline – Oxbridge applicants, + Medicine, Veterinary, Dentistry & other 'Early Applications' Midwifery & Child Nursing applicants
<b>15 October*</b>	UCAS closing date for Oxbridge applicants _ Medicine, Veterinary, Dentistry & Midwifery applicants
<b>14 October</b>	College deadline – all 'on-time' UCAS applicants
<b>2012</b>	
<b>15 January*</b>	Deadline date for UCAS to receive applications
<b>Jan/Feb</b>	Student Finance (if not already achieved)
<b>Late February</b>	UCAS 'Extra' starts
<b>24 March</b>	UCAS final closing date for Art & Design courses <b>except</b> those listed with a 15 January deadline
<b>25 March – 30 June</b>	'Late applications' will be considered by the universities at their discretion. Explanation for lateness in Personal Statement (UCAS decisions by: 19 July)
<b>2 May</b>	College deadline for 'late' UCAS applicants
<b>30 June</b>	Applications received after 30 June are entered in 'Clearing'
<b>18 August</b>	A level results day & UCAS 'Clearing' begins

**\* The same closing date apply for deferred applications.**

It is important that you recognise the difference between UCAS deadlines and internal College deadlines. The dates given above are the ones which you need to take notice of and work towards. Provided your on-line application form is completed, payment made, and 'sent to Referee' (your Personal Tutor) by the relevant date it is **guaranteed** that the UCAS deadline will be met. If it is not submitted by the College deadlines, we cannot guarantee it will meet the UCAS deadline and you may fail to secure a uni place.
